Herewith our comments to the undermentioned reports and the application.

APPENDIX 16 – AIR QUALITY IMPACT ASSESMENT

1. To determine potential impact on ambient environment and air quality sensitivity receptors.
2. There is indeed **no weather station or air quality station** in the area. The nearest stations are in Booyens, Pretoria (East) and at Xanadu Country Estate in North West province.
3. The area experiences air pollution from the burning of waste (household, plastic, dog kennel excrement etc.)
4. The Magalies Conservancy contacted the City of Tshwane for assistance.

5. The burning of household waste and/or farming or business-related waste currently contributes to health problems.
6. The air quality was based on a data assumption made by the specialist.
7. There are no corroborating statements or evidence.
8. **NO** report from an **Occupational Health Practitioner** was included.
9. On 14 August 2024 GDARD BIODIVERSITY STEWARDSHIP visited the area.
10. Mr Ferdi de Beer from Mog Doc Pty Ltd drove the Mr Solly Shishenge, Mr Petrus Links and Ida van der Schyf to the towers at the top of the Magaliesberg.
11. It is the personal experience of Mrs Ida van der Schyf that a strong wind was blowing from south to north and a strong wind was blowing upwards at the towers on top of the Magaliesberg.
12. In the past 20 years there have been two (2) tornado's that swept through the valley.
13. **It cannot be acceptable practice** to grant environmental authorisation or a water use licence, with a report **suggesting that an air monitoring system** must be implemented **after** the mining starts.
