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Good day Danie

1. As briefly mentioned this morning, I would like to provide a response to the below with regards to the parrot breeding centre and the impact on their facility/birds:

The below is from the meeting minutes:

- Ms Alet du Preez said they have been breeding with parrots which are a registered endangered specie since 2007. According to the breeding agreement the location of breeding could not be changed. In order to achieve this the mine may not conduct blasting activities during July to December, which is the breeding time of the parrots. What solution can be proposed as it was not easy to register the breeding program.
- Mr Zeeman said it has been noted and an investigation will be done and feedback given.

They are located at 20 Loots St, which is just outside the 120dB air blast range for the minimum charge.

2. The minutes indicate that the complaints process needs to be advertised. Is this correct?

- Mr Zeeman replied there will be a pre photographic record completed and if there is damage afterwards such records could be adjudicated and compared. A complaints process needs to be followed which should be **documented and advertised** after which inspection on the house will be done. It normally follows the rout of an insurance claim.
